THE ROLE OF A VICE CHAIRPERSON:

The role of the Vice Chairperson (VC) varies depending on the size of the region in which you are serving. However, all VCs need to have web access, as well as an email address, in addition to being supportive of MIT and enthusiastic about meeting both young people and other alumni/ae.

VCs who are in one of five very large metropolitan areas are required to perform all the duties of a Regional Chairperson.

The majority of VCs will act primarily in an EC capacity while being willing and ready to support the activities of the RC and serve as his or her backup when necessary. VCs must understand that they are considered to be an RC in training, and should be motivated to step into that role temporarily or on a long-term basis when the time comes.
